#### **Guild Business and Announcements**

 The Anthem Ranch Fine Art Sale and Show will be on June 21<sup>st</sup>. Set up will be the day before with the take down and clean up held right after the show.

- A watercolor workshop will be held on April 17<sup>th</sup> between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm. Kathleen Lanzoni, a Boulder-based watercolor artist and teacher will conduct the workshop. Details regarding cost and materials will be sent out well prior to the workshop.
- Gale Simonson informed the group about coming opportunities for plein air painting at Metzger Farms this Summer and Fall, May 24<sup>th</sup> and September 27<sup>th</sup>. (This latter date will conflict with our setting up for the Fall Member Show.)
- Dave pointed out the need for more volunteers to step up to help out with set up and takedown at the Library, Anthem and Fall Member shows.

# **On-going exhibits:**

- Library the first hanging will be on February 20th and will run to mid-April. The second hanging will be mid-April through June, so we will have five months of display time in 2025. We will need volunteers to help hang the art since the City has given us that responsibility.
- BCC set up is March 3rd; deadline to sign up is February 21st. Take down will be May 30th at 1:00.
- iPie Judy and Dave Shelley are holding a joint showing this month.
- City Hall –Tanya Tenorio has some large art pieces on display until the end of February
- Brunner Roger Carver is showing his art for the rest of February, having stepped up when the Photo Club needed to delay its display until March.
   Next activity will be in May with either a New Member show or an artist display.

For Art Sharing, we had probably 12 artists share their excellent examples artwork.

Guest Artist was Carol Nelson, a nationally known abstract geologic artist. She gave a delightful, entertaining and educational demonstration of some of her techniques, such as making rocks from plaster of Paris, and shared a few pieces of her artwork. Everyone who stayed was enthusiastic and engaged. Carol answered many questions and likely inspired many of us to try some of her tips and techniques.
