Thirty-five members of the Art Guild were present, including one new member.

Guild Business and Announcements

- Gale shared a list of books Selma Payne found were available at College Hill Library regarding drawing and painting using methods similar to those followed by Tanner Steed. The books are by Juliette Aristides and include:

- She also shared a book that Selma had discovered that shows all the public art sculptures in and around Broomfield.
- Dave showed a couple samples of new Guild merchandise and some other things that members could purchase like aprons, hats, and stickers. More details and order forms will be available at the next meeting.
- Dave discussed the photo spread in the Enterprise and outlined the process for this continuing opportunity.

Another call for paintings will go out in April for a display beginning May 5th and run through the end of June. We will be rotating the Hallway display every two months at first.
