Art Share Time:

Members shared artwork, many where they've tried a new technique or medium and several artists shared very moving personal stories about their work.

Artist Demo:

Members welcomed back Suzette Rosenthal, who had been a Guild President some time ago. Suzette Rosenthal is a Broomfield artist working primarily in mixed media. Suzette demonstrated her collage technique and building visual interest with various papers and ephemera. Suzette demonstrated layering with items like gift bags, maps, candy foils, old phone book paper and more and also how to add color or texture with items like produce bags, bubble wrap and punchinella. Works made from layering can be abstract or images can be transferred (gel transfer, stamps, collaged images) and arranged to create an interesting composition or story.
