Tip shared during this time: Try using Golden's Open Acrylics for Plein Air- it's acrylic paint but stays wet longer.

Demo Artist <u>Kelly Austin Rolo</u> showed us her encaustic printing technique by applying wax to a hot plate, creating designs and texture in the wax with various tools and then pulling an image up by pressing paper onto the wax. Members had the opportunity to try their own design if desired.
