Gale gave an update on the upcoming Plein Aire event at Metzger Farms: The Nature Festival and Plein Aire event is this Saturday, August 17th, from 10 to 2.

There is a Parking issue: We cannot park at Metzger. They want us to drop supplies off and then park across the street at the church. A golf cart will help transport people, and Gale will also ferry people back and forth as needed. If you can and don't mind the walk, there's an underpass that you can walk from the church to Metzger (under Lowell).

You can paint for as long as you want. The event is 10 am-2pm, but you can set up as early as 8:30 am to paint and leave when you're done.

Many nature and wildlife organizations will be there, and we want to have a presence.

Update from Judy on Anthem Highlands:

Judy, Gale, and Dave met with the third lifestyle director at Highlands and asked about using their gymnasium or a large multi-purpose room for an art sale event. He just has to get permission from his Board first to reserve the gymnasium for a Saturday. We'd have to get there early for the screen set up (first Saturday in November—Holiday Sale).

They'll continue working with this new director to try to set up this art sale.

We still need to find out about refreshments, how many screens are available, and who has their own to bring. (Screens are at least \$100 per screen—we may invest in more at some point/ possibly rent/ ask the fairgrounds board or other event space/ party supply about screen rentals.)
